Brats and Brews Festival, featuring Jimmy Sturr, to kick off August 13 & 14 at Hunter Mountain
On-site camping available!

HUNTER, NY – Hunter Mountain’s annual Brats and Brews Festival is scheduled to kick off Saturday & Sunday, August 13 & 14, 2011. The festival stars 18-time Grammy Award Winner Jimmy Sturr and His Orchestra, and includes other acts from far and wide, including die Fahrenbacher from Graz, Austria, die Schlauberger, the Alex Meixner Band, the Adlers and others. Brats and Brews, which began at Hunter Mountain in 1976, was previously known as the German Alps Festival; the name was changed in 2010.

The two days include food, art and craft vendors, plus a variety of entertainers, bands, DJs and German dancers. Taking place throughout Hunter’s base lodge and grounds, the festival will take place rain or shine and will provide plenty of space and multiple entertainment stages, plus German-American food and drink. Hunter Mountain’s Skyride will be operating over the weekend, allowing festival-goers to take the chairlift to the summit of the resort—hours of operation and pricing can be found on HunterMtn.com. New York Zipline Adventure Tours will also be operating; reservations are strongly recommended and can be made by calling 800-486-8376.

Festival grounds will open at 11am on Saturday, August 13, and live entertainment will end at 9:30pm with fireworks on Saturday night. The festival will begin again at 11am on Sunday with entertainment ending at 6pm. Admission to the festival is \$9.00 per person if purchased early on eSki.HunterMtn.com or \$12 at the door; camping access is \$15 for Saturday night, and also can be purchased online.
