Hunter Mountain Continues to Expand its Terrain Park with New Features for the 2011/2012 Season
Two new builds; plus resurrection of older features & sponsored additions in the works

This season Hunter’s Park staff is building two new features, the first being two-3” single-barrel rails mounted side by side for transfers. Another is a low 20’ funbox. Thirty Two, the California-based snowboarding company, will continue to work closely with Hunter to create fun contests and events.
